# kindle

### **WestlawNext** (<http://lawschol.westlaw.com>)

Send WestlawNext documents directly to your Kindle. Look for this option under the “Select a delivery method” menu on the right side of the screen. Amazon charges a fee for this service (\$.15 per download).

### **Mobipocket Creator** (<http://www.mobipocket.com>)

Use this PC/Mac software application to convert PDFs to a format which can be annotated on your Kindle. Free.



## iPhone

### **Fastcase** (<http://www.fastcase.com>)

Search federal and state cases and statutes as well as save research documents for later reading. Free (paid upgrades available).

### **Accessmylibrary** (<http://www.accessmylibrary.com/>)

Access powerful databases from GALE to research business information and find news articles. Uses local public library subscriptions. Free.

### **DroidLaw** (<http://droidlaw.com/>)

A pocket library that includes the US Federal Rules of civil procedure, evidence, appellate procedure, criminal procedure, and bankruptcy procedure. The basic app is free; add-ons include US Historical Docs (Constitution, Articles of Confederation, Declaration of Independence, free), United States Code (\$6.99), US Supreme Court Cases (\$2.99), and selected state statutes and rules.

### **ezPDF Reader** (<http://bit.ly/dtcezpdf>)

Read PDFs and bookmark pages; includes text search. \$0.99

**RDM+** (<http://www.rdmplus.com/>)

Access files on your home and office computers, edit Word documents, and manage files and folders. \$39.99

**BeamReader** (<http://www.slgmobile.com/beamreader.html>)

Read PDF documents from attachments, a memory card, or internal memory. \$9.99

Search WestlawNext, access your research folders, review your search history, and annotate documents. Free.

**Noterize** (<http://itunes.apple.com/app/noterize/id364906681?mt=8>)

Annotate PDFs with highlights, text notes, and free hand drawing. Can also be used as a portable notebook. Price includes a coupon for 15% off a Pogo Sketch stylus.
